





Snowfa

n my first ski trip, I dislocated my shoulder - twice: once while coming down a gentle blue slope, the second time holding onto a rafter in a heaving bar. It was a minor setback and nothing that couldn't be eased away with a schnapps or two. The next day I was back on the slopes – albeit a little more cautiously. The thrill of the white powder outweighed the fear of falling.

There's something to be said for the silence you experience at the top of a run, the "whoosh" as other skiers whizz by, the crisp air in your lungs as you slowly climb the mountains in the cable car, a winter wonderland spread out beneath you. In Austria, you can add another element to this - a very festive après-ski,



which swings into action from 4pm each day. Here the mountain bars and village pubs come alive as skiers and snowboarders party, boots and all. Beers flow, schnapps is knocked back and cheesy music gets the crowd moving. It's loud, a little smelly and often messy - but always fun.

> Many resorts offer good snow and great parties, but there's something special about Westendorf. Located in the Brixen Valley away from the main roads, it's a picture-perfect village surrounded by mountains. Alpine aesthetics aside, it's also ideal for families due to the small size of the town, the slightly quieter slopes and the more chilled nightlife.

Westendorf used to be pretty isolated in

terms of skiing, but since the construction of the Ki-West gondola and another one spanning the Brixen Valley, it's now part of the Skiwelt, Austria's largest interconnected ski area - which means easy access to over 350km of runs for all levels, from beginners to advanced. Just keep an eye on your watch and allow yourself time to ski back to the base, or you'll be in for an expensive taxi ride home.

With packages cheaper than the A-list French and Italian resorts, it's one of the best options for South Africans right now.

BOOKINGS

Due to the lower-than-average altitude, the best snow is usually between December and March. Ten-night Christmas packages are available from €1 255 and a sevennight New Year package from €1 020. www.skiwithaail.com

SAA flies direct to Munich, Germany, seven days a week. A 90-minute coach transfer will see you in Westendorf. - Ingrid Wood



LESOTHO An easy weekend skiing getaway for locals? You bet!

f your budget's a little tight, but you're keen on a skiing experience, Afriski – in Lesotho's Maluti Mountains - is only a five-hour drive from Johannesburg. Once you cross the Caledonspoort borderpost in Fouriesburg in the Free State, it's 80km inland.

With a modest 1km main ski run serviced by a T-bar lift, you can't compare it with the international resorts in terms of the ski experience, but it does offer a ski school, qualified instructors, passes, ski hire, food and accommodation on site. Ideal for family fun, it has good areas for beginners to find

their ski legs. It's also a great mid-year snow fix for more advanced skiers and snowboarders. (The Afriski Race Club hosts a series of alpine ski competitions as part of its Ski Grand Prix series.)

At 3 222m above sea level, you're pretty much guaranteed snow over June and July, but due to the team of snowmakers, you can experience groomed, prepared slopes throughout winter. The temperatures can drop very low, so be prepared. The accommodation at Afriski is basic, but good and limited, so book early. It's better to stay on site as it can be quite a drive to the next-best option and the roads are tricky a 4x4 is advised.

TIP: We found the kids' ski instructor rather impatient, which unsettled the little ones, so ensure you select the right one for your needs. www.afriski.net - Ingrid Wood







CANADA Expect a thrill a minute – without the crowds

Boards and lodging



Ithough only becoming an official sport in the Winter Olympic Games in 1988, snowboarding dates back to Turkey some 500 years ago, where the boards were basic wooden planks and bindings were absent. Today, thanks to Tom Sims, founder of Sims Snowboards and Mike Olsen, founder of Gnu Snowboards, as well as materials such as fibreglass and polyethylene, the sport's faster and fiercer than ever before.

SEEING IT FROM THE SKIES

Helicopters were added to the sport in western Canada by Canadian Mountain Holidays around 50 years ago. Today it runs 11 lodges around the Columbia Mountains north of Calgary. The boon of heli-boarding lies in the access it offers to pristine snow and private slopes. Then, of course, there's the thrill of steep, deep tree-boarding, open alpine runs and glacier terrain.

WHERE TO STAY

Valemount Lodge: A private, exclusive-use lodge for 10 people which comes complete with a Bell 212 helicopter, two guides, a full spa (with in-room massages) and a chef cooking family-style fare. The rooms include private baths and balconies offering views of Canada's finest slopes.

Gothics Lodge: Recently revamped, this casual mountain lodge is best for snowhungry groups of friends. It facilitates yoga and has a well-stocked wine cellar too.

Ithough a long way from SA, Niseko Village in Hokkaido, on the northernmost island of Japan, receives up to 18m of the most powdery, lightest and fluffiest snow in the world each year, as well as supremely well-organised resorts which combine the Japanese aesthetic of hospitality and painstaking attention to detail. The village is the centre of the area's nightlife, attracting fun-seekers from around the globe.

WHERE TO STAY

Green Leaf Resort: A boutique-type resort offering access to gondolas and a ski-in, ski-out facility that gets you up the slopes easily. With a fantastic spa and hot inside and outside onsen options, the after-snow relaxation is celebrated.

he secret's out about the globe's most transcendental destination for snowboarding: Gulmarg in north-western India. Discovered by outstationed British soldiers in 1927, the area's known for its heavy snowfall and provides a staggering 1 500m of vertical boarding. The fact that there are very few

queues and wide-open slopes means it could even be just you on them, enjoying a perfect opportunity to contemplate your surroundings in solitary wonder.



WHERE TO STAY

Khyber Hotel: A traditional Indian lodge with all the modern amenities expected of a luxury hotel, including an array of speciality restaurants, a cigar lounge, spa facilities and a kids' zone. www.khyberhotels.com
