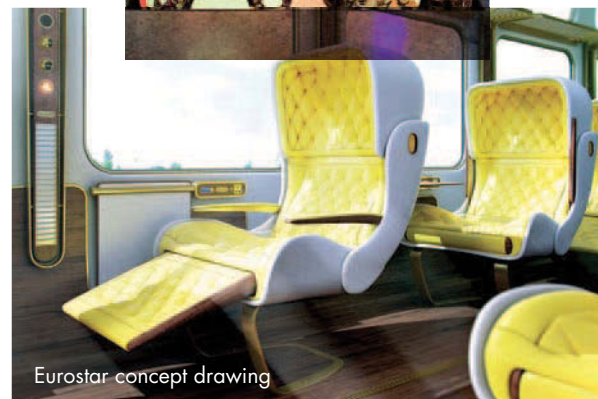
Christopher Jenner

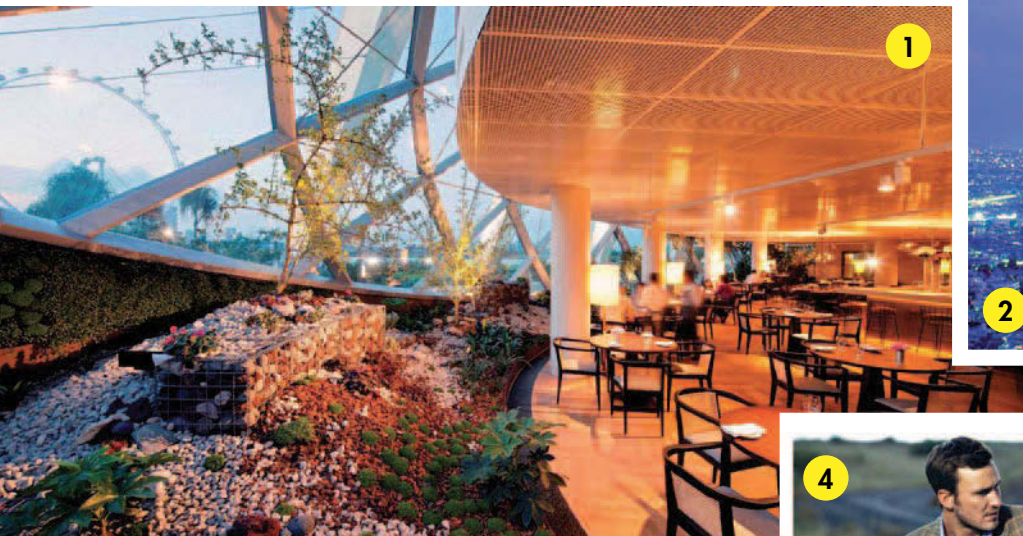
